Cal Poly Architectural Engineering Student Receives Narver Scholarship from SEAOSC

SAN LUIS OBISPO – Marga Lamoreaux, a senior architectural engineering student, received one of two Margaret Narver Memorial Scholarships awarded by the Structural Engineers Association of Southern California (SEAOSC) and the Structural Engineers Auxiliary. The scholarship, in the amount of \$1,500, was given for the first time this year in memory of Pat Narver, a founding member and long-standing treasurer of the auxiliary. Lamoreaux received the scholarship from David Narver at a February 7 dinner meeting of the SEAOSC in Los Angeles.

The group annually selects and presents scholarships to outstanding students from southern and central California universities that have engineering programs that include an emphasis in structures. Students are nominated by their faculty and must submit a short paper about their interest in structural engineering. Other considerations include a resume, academic merits and extra curricular activities related to the major.

At the time of the award Lamoreaux was president of the student chapter of the SEAOC in the Architectural Engineering Department at Cal Poly. She hopes to pursue graduate school in structural engineering after graduating from Cal Poly in Fall of 2007.
