2001-2002**

Harold Hay is a strong supporter of sustainable design in the building sciences. Over the past few years he has generously made funds available to encourage the study of sustainable design principles especially in the demonstration of the use of water as a “material” in architecture.

AWARD: One (1) \$500 and two (2) awards of \$250

CRITERIA: Scholarship award is granted on the basis of:

- 1) Demonstration (current or previous) of integration of environmental and sustainable design principles and building sciences concepts in a major studio project.
- 2) Demonstration (current or previous) of a utilization of a valid sustainable design content in other parts of the CAED curriculum (e.g. site analysis using environmental design content in a graphics design project).
- 3) Demonstration of the use of water as a “material” in architecture.
- 4) Scholarship in Environmental Control Systems (ECS) courses and other Science course work.
- 5) Demonstrated scholastic achievement.

ELIGIBILITY: Any student currently enrolled in the College of Architecture and Environmental Design may apply.

SELECTION PROCESS: The CAED Scholarship Committee will review all work and select the recipient(s).

APPLICATION: Applications must be received by the CAED receptionist on or before 5:00 PM, Friday, April 13, 2001.

NOTIFICATION: Recipients will be notified in May and will be recognized at the CAED Awards Reception held May 20, 2001, starting at 2:00 PM in Chumash Auditorium. The funds will be available after July 30, 2001, for use in Academic Year 2001-2002.
